GAME TRAIL ASSOCIATION RULE AND REGULATION 11-02 REGULATION OF HORSES WITHIN GAME TRAIL

Rule and Regulation 08-01 is hereby suspended and superseded by this Rule and Regulation.

As used in this Rule and Regulation, "horse" shall mean horse, pony, mule, donkey, or hinny.

Horses may be kept on private property owned by Association Members of lots within Game Trail Filing Three as provided in Supplemental Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, dated September 27, 1985, filed of record in Book 480, Page 174, Clerk and Recorder's Office, Chaffee County, Colorado.

Other than in the foregoing declaration, no horse may be kept on Game Trail private or common property, road, or conservation area. This Rule and Regulation is intended to prohibit riding, leading, stabling, corralling, pasturing, training, rendering of medical treatment, and driving or being a passenger upon a horse, whether mounted or unmounted.

The failure of an Association Member to abide by this Rule and Regulation may result in the imposition of fines or other remedies described in the Bylaws of Game Trail Association, Inc. The Board of Directors may also assess the Association Member in violation any costs, including reasonable attorney fees, incurred by the Association in enforcing this Rule and Regulation.
