

96-02 Vehicular Entry Into the National Forest. [Adopted July 18, 1996.]

A. In cooperation with U.S. Forest Service policy of controlling vehicular access to the National Forest other than by public roads, any entry by a vehicle into the adjoining U.S. National Forest from Game Trail property is prohibited. Also prohibited is overnight occupancy of the U. S. National Forest in motor homes, travel trailers, other types of recreational vehicles, or any other form of shelter which have entered the National Forest from Game Trail Subdivision.

B. To adequately enforce this Rule and Regulation the Association hereby establishes a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each separate violation of this Rule and Regulation, such fine to be assessed according to the Bylaws of the Association. Furthermore, each day until the offending vehicle or shelter is removed from the National Forest shall be a separate violation of these Rules and Regulations and subject the property owner to a fine of \$100.00 per day.
